brand new state of the art paint booth, a work area, a well organized storage area on the second floor where they store parts for each car currently in the shop, a final assembly area, a showroom, a lunch room and of course the office area. Pictured above and center are photos of the work area, parts storage and the showroom.

Last but not least we are featuring Tin Element, LLC. This

shop is owned and operated by Neal Kurschner along with one employee, Shawn. Neal started Tin Element, LLC in 2009 having many years of experience and training including WyoTech in Laramie, Wyoming and a few years working at Pinkee's. Tin Element specializes in metal body work and fabrication on all domestic and European cars and trucks, from high-end exotic aluminum bodied cars to street rods and muscle cars to original restorations and resto-mods. I did an article back in 2016 on Tin Element when they were still located in Loveland, Colorado where their shop had about 2,100 square feet. They needed more space so



they moved a couple of years ago to a larger facility in Broomfield where they now have approximately 3,800 square feet of space including office space and storage space in an upstairs loft area. Neal and Shawn do some amazing metal work which is the basis of any great paint job. They are capable of performing metal work, including aluminum, that requires no filler or bondo. When they are done with the metal work, the correct primer and sanding is typically all that is required. While they specialize primarily in metal work, they can also provide custom chassis and suspension fabrication, drivetrain installations and even complete

turn-key projects. In most cases, metal work is rarely recognized adequately when describing the restoration or build of any car. Fact is, it is the metal work and fabrication that is the foundation of every great car. 
